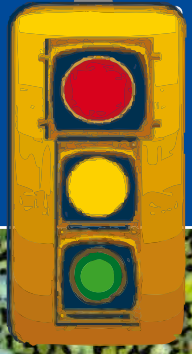

# Stop, Look and Listen

First, find a safe place to cross where you can see what's coming. Then:

**STOP** at the edge of the sidewalk or road.

**LOOK** to your left and your right before you start to cross. Make absolutely sure you don't see any vehicles or bicycles approaching.

**LISTEN** for vehicles that you might not be able to see.

When all is clear, cross the road quickly while continue **LOOKING** in both directions.

## Also remember these valuable road safety tips:

- Cars might be going faster than you think, so make sure you have enough time to cross the road safely.
- Always use the pedestrian crossing if there is one.
- Don't ever walk in the road, but stay to the side or use the sidewalk.
- Wear bright clothes when walking at night.
- Cars need room to stop, so never rush out onto the road.
